Now available at select Arden Theatre Company performances

SMART CAPTION GLASSES

are a new accessibility service available at Arden Theatre Company performances, starting approximately one week after Opening Night.

These provide a personalized captioning experience using a synchronized transcript of the play's dialogue and sound effects.

Upon request, you will receive a pair of glasses and an attached controller to tailor the experience to your needs. An Arden staff member will guide you through how to do so and make sure that you can see the text that is already scrolling on the Glasses.

FOR YOUR SAFETY

Please use the provided lanyard to hang the device around your neck.

Do not wear the Smart Caption Glasses while walking around the lobby or climbing stairs. Please wait to put them on once you are settled in your seat for the performance.

Remove the Glasses before getting up from your seat during or after the performance.

USING THE GLASSES

The glasses are able to be worn over your normal glasses. The nose piece is strong; you can squeeze and expand it as much as you need to make the glasses sit comfortably on your nose.

Tap the controller screen to view the menu.

You will see options to customize how the text appears in your glasses. You are able to adjust the glasses at any point during the show if you find you don't like your previous settings anymore.



BRIGHTNESS

Changes how light or dark the text appears.



COLOR

Changes the text color (Options include white, yellow, blue, green, red, and pink).



POSITION

Changes where in your vision the text appears. Aim to position it in a spot with a dark background.



TEXT SIZE

Changes how large or small the script text appears.



FOCUS

Changes how near or far the script text appears.
