





A Message from our Honorary Producers

Many consider *RENT*, the 1996 Pulitzer Prize-winning musical, one of the most influential productions of all time. It arrives on the Arden's Mainstage at a pivotal moment. While theater audiences are finally reaching their pre-pandemic numbers, our world is as fragile as ever. Set amid a raging epidemic, *RENT*'s themes of love, loss and class warfare remain just as relevant today, further illustrating how the human plight endures, regardless of time and place.

This wonderful show holds an extra-special place in my heart. My dear brother Richard died from AIDS in 1995, and his loss was still quite painful when *RENT* opened on Broadway a year later. Listening to "Seasons of Love" brought all my heartache to the fore, but also great comfort. Our lives are not measured by our successes or failures, but by love. As the Tin Man tells Dorothy in *The Wizard of Oz*, "a heart is not judged by how much you love, but by how much you are loved by others."

Jonathan Larson reminds us that tomorrow is not guaranteed for any of us and that love is our greatest legacy.

David and I hope you enjoy the Arden's production of RENT!

A Note From the Co-Director



"We the People Won't Go"

When we started dreaming up what this production could be months and months ago, our scenic designer, Paige, brought a whole bunch of inspiration images with her - streets in the East Village, outdoor markets, protests, performance spaces - all very gritty, real snapshots of New York City in the 1990's. But one photo really stood out. It was of an abandoned building that had been taken over by squatters, with a large painted banner that read "We the People Won't Go." And the wheels started turning...

RENT is the story of people who are fighting for something that is fundamental, whether it be a roof over their heads, money to buy food, overcoming grief and heartbreak, justice and equality, the ability to love who you're gonna love and most poignantly...people simply fighting for their lives. The HIV/AIDS epidemic was essentially a death sentence for nearly the first decade of its existence because those in power chose not to deal with it. That's where the "Silence = Death" saying comes from. We are very fortunate to have effective treatments and preventative measures available for a lot of people today (though still not everyone), and that is a direct result of the work of so many in the LGBTQIA+ community and our allies that stood up and demanded to be seen, demanded to be heard and demanded a different ending to this chapter. We the people won't go! When we work together, when we build community, when we celebrate our differences as things that make US more beautiful, we have more strength than we could ever individually realize. But the struggle is still real and the fight continues. It's almost like it's just a part of who we, the people, are.

It has been a gift to create with this community of artists and this community at the Arden. And I am personally so happy you're joining us to see the musical that changed my life nearly 30 years ago! Welcome! And for the record, Jonathan Larson wasn't gay and he didn't die of AIDS. He just had the empathetic heart, mind and spirit of an artist who knows that sometimes choosing to LOVE is the most audacious choice to be made in a world that seems to be tearing itself and each other apart.

Happy Seasons of Love to all who celebrate!

Yes WE can.







JONATHAN LARSON (Book, Music, and Lyrics) received the 1996 Pulitzer Prize for Drama for *RENT*. He also won the 1996 Tony Award for Best Musical and the 1994 Richard Rodgers Award for *RENT* and twice received The Gilman & Gonzales-Falla Theatre Foundation's Comendation Award. In 1989 he was granted the Stephen Sondheim Award from American Music Theatre Festival, where he contributed to the musical *Sitting on the Edge of the Future*. In 1988 he won the Richard Rodgers Development Grant for his rock musical *Superbia*, which was staged at Playwrights Horizons. He composed the score for the musical *J.P. Morgan Saves the Nation*, which was presented by En Garde Arts in 1995. Mr. Larson performed his rock monologue *tick*, *tick... BOOM!* at Second Stage Theatre, The Village Gate, and New York Theatre Workshop. In addition to scoring and song writing for "Sesame Street", he created music for a number fo children's book-cassettes, including Steven Spielberg's *An American Tale* and *Land Before Time*. Other film scores include work for Rolling Stones magazine publisher Jann Wenner. He conceived, directed and wrote four original songs for *Away We Go!*, a musical video for children. *RENT*, his rock opera based on *La Boheme*, had its world premiere on February 13, 1996 at New York Theatre Workshop. Mr. Larson died unexpectedly of an aortic aneurysm on January 25, 1996, ten days before his 36th birthday. His music (including songs cut from his shows) is archived in the Library of Congress.

TERRENCE J. NOLEN (Co-Driector) is Co-founder and Producing Artistic Director of Arden Theatre Company. Favorite Arden productions include all-Philadelphia casts of *The Lehman Trilogy, August: Osage County, Death of a Salesman,* and *Hedda Gabler*; and such musicals as *Next to Normal, Sweeney Todd: The Demon Barber of Fleet Street, Pacific Overtures, Violet,* and *Caroline, or Change.* Terry directed the inaugural production of Arden Children's Theatre, *Charlotte's Web.* He has directed eight world-premiere plays by

He directed Michael Hollinger's *Opus* at Primary Stages in New York and was nominated for a Lucille Lortel Award for Outstanding Director. His short film *The Personal Touch* was nominated for an Emmy Award.
