## CLASSES FOR GRADES 3-5

### ACTOR'S TOOLBOX: Creating Characters

Saturdays, 10:00–12:00 am, \$235 per kid

Students create and perform short scenes in character, gaining insight into storytelling through the lens of character development.

### MUSICAL THEATRE: Dance with Style

Saturdays, 12:30–2:30 pm, \$250 per kid

## CLASSES FOR GRADES 9-12
